Colleen Rini stated the CDC and the school board do not have the authority to mandate students wear masks, that decision should be left with the parents.

Russ Owens stated he was appreciative for the opportunity to voice his opinions. He stated at the August board meeting the district stated they would not require masks unless the data provided a reason to do so and he was upset at the special meeting without additional data, the district wanted to support a mask mandate.

Chad Heilman stated he was appreciative for the board to listen to the community and that he will continue to show up at board meetings.

Kathrine stated she was upset and disappointed in the board for its decision to leave masks optional. She stated the Supreme Court decisions and Ohio law as to why students should be masked in schools.

Mike Moses stated people should be respectful to staff and that he understands the decision but wanted the Board to keep its options open.
